From Moor Pool Hall to corner of Circle and Moorpool Avenue

- *Arts and Crafts planning, landscaping, and architecture*

Up Northgate and take path off to allotments

- *Pathway network; Planned Open Spaces between houses*

Pathway through to Park Edge

- *Planting for “Moor Pool in Bloom”*

Listed Flats, one of two sets on Ravenhurst Road

- *Special architectural features*

Along Margaret Grove

- *Curvilinear road design; Architectural features; site of first Bowling Green*

Junction of Moorpool Avenue and Park Hill Road

- *First House on the estate; site of “first” Sod-cutting*

Up Moorpool Avenue – tennis courts on right. Cross Ravenhurst Road towards path by Pool and Bowling Green

- *Listed flats(2) (and entrance to ‘site A’)*

Along Pool and Bowling Green path.

- *Resident heron? moor-hens? ducks definitely*

Drop off at Bowling Green if wish (open today), or continue and turn up path on left to Moorpool Avenue and the Hall.
